Whereupon the said William and Mary at the prayer of the said Tunstall and Spencer made by John Caldwell their procheinamy are adjudged to give special bail to the action aforesaid

Thereupon also certain Thomas Fletcher and Barber Selby both of Somerset County Gentlemen present here in Court in their proper persons did assume upon themselves and undertake and each of them did undertake for the said William and Mary that if in case the said Tunstall and Spencer should recover Judgment in the plea as against the said William and Mary, or that the said William and Mary should be therein convicted that then the said William and Mary should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or Render their Bodies to the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in Satisfaction hereof or that they the same Thomas Fletcher and Barber Selby will do the same for them

Thereupon the said William Wye and Mary his wife by William Deeringham their attorney came and defend the force and injury when he and pray Leave thereof to Impare here until next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the said Tunstall and Spencer made here also

At which said next Court to with the Twentieth day of June and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the said Tunstall and Spencer made by John Caldwell their procheinamy as the said William and Mary by their attorney as and thereupon the said William and Mary pray further Leave thereof to Impare here until next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the said Tunstall and Spencer here also

At which said next Court to with the fifteenth day of August and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the said Tunstall and Spencer made by John Caldwell their procheinamy
