the same Tunstall and Spencer well and faithfully would content and pay nevertheless the said Mary whilst she
was sole and the said William and Mary since the espousals between them celebrated the promise and assumption
as of the aforesaid Mary whilst she was sole and made Little regarding but plotting and fraudulently detrac-
ting the same Tunstall and Spencer in that part craftily and subtilly to defraud and deceive neither the said
Mary whilst she was sole nor the said William Since the espousals between them celebrated the said sum
of five thousand Six hundred and Ninety Eight pounds of Tobaco and Seventy pounds Current money after-
wards or any part thereof to the same Tunstall and Spencer hath paid or them for it in any wise content-
ed altho the same Mary afterwards to witt the same day and year as whilst she was sole and the said
William and Mary Since the espousals between them celebrated the tenth day of November Seven
hundred and Ninety One at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court were therunto Re-
quested but they the same hitherto to pay or the same Tunstall and Spencer for the same in any wise to
satisfie have altogether Refused and still doth Refuse whereby the same Tunstall and Spencer say
they are worse and have damage to the value of Seventy Eight pounds Current money of Maryland and
Six thousand pounds of Tobaco and thereof they bring Suit ... --- Indepleasit fiam: pro Quo -

Whereupon the said William and Mary at the prayer of the said Tunstall and Spencer made by John Col-
well their attorney are adjudged to give special bail to the action aforesaid.

Thereupon aforesaid Thomas Fletcher and Barker Selby both of Somerset County Gentlemen present here
in Court in their proper persons did assume upon themselves and undertake and each of them did under-
take for the said William and Mary that if in case the said Tunstall and Spencer should Recover Judg't in the
plea as against the said William and Mary or that the said William and Mary should be thereto Convict that
then the said William and Mary shall pay the Condemnation of the Court there upon or Render their Bodys to
the custody of the Just. of Somerset County in Satisfaction hereof or that they the same Thomas Fletcher and
Barker Selby will do the same for them.

Thereupon the said William Wye and Mary his wife by William Beckingham their attorney
come and defend the free and injury where he and pray leave thereof to Imparte heremt next Court and
they have it and the same day is given to the said Tunstall and Spencer made here also.

All which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of June and Dord. One thousand Seven hundred &
Ninety two Pm againe as well the said Tunstall and Spencer made by John Colwell their attorney
as the said William and Mary by their attorney as and thereupon the said William and Mary pray further
Leave thereof to Imparte here in the next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the said Tunstall
and Spencer here also etc:
