Provide and where they are silent according to the Laws Statutes and
Reasonable Customs of England as used and practised within this province
for the Conservation of the Peace and Quiet Rule and Government of
The Kings Subjects within our said County and to Chastise and Punish
all or any Person or Persons Offending Against the said acts Laws Statutes
and Customs or any of them according to the Directions thereof and to call
Before you or any of you all those who in our County aforesaid shall
Threaten to do any bodily harm to any of the Kings Subjects or to burn
Their Houses or otherwise break our peace and Misbehave Themselves
to find sufficient Securitie of the Peace and Good behaviour to us and
