Upon the motion of Henry Ballard. Jack a negro man of Maria Ballard is set free for the future by the Court &c.

Toby a negro boy of George Howard's is adjudged by the Court to be eight years of age this term &c.

Peter a negro boy of David Bolts is adjudged by the Court to be nine years of age this term &c.

Adam a negro boy of Thomas Robinson is adjudged by the Court to be Seven years of age this term &c.

Dick a negro boy of Philip Adams is adjudged by the Court to Nine years of age this term &c.

Rose a negro girl of William Cox is adjudged by the Court to Eleven years of age this term &c.

Jeffry Long.] Jewel Long an Orphan above the age of fourteen years came heneinto Court
Guardian to [in his proper person and prayeth that he may be admitted to those a certan Jeffry
Jewell Long. Long of Somerset County planter as his guardian which is unto him granted &c.

Whereupon the said Jewel Long present herein Court as aforesaid makes choice of the said Jeffry Long as his guardian &c. Whereupon it is ordered that Samuel Long of Somerset County planter (who hath the Estate of the said Jewel Long in his possession) deliver up unto the aforesaid Jeffry Long
Guardian as aforesaid all the Estate personale of the said Jewel Long that he hath in his hands peaceably and quietly, and further it is ordered that the said Jeffry Long his Guardian aforesaid receive
the same whole and give security to comply with the guardianship aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Jeffry Long with Daniel Long Senr. and Samuel Long of Marum who
his security both of Somerset County planters are present herein Court in their proper persons
acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto the said Jewel Long in the sum of One hundred
pound Sterling of their severall goods and Chattells Lands and tenements jointly and severally
to the use of the said Jewel Long his heirs and assignes to be made and levied. If it
happen that the aforesaid Jeffry Long do not comply with the same in Relation to the guardian
as aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Jewel Long his heirs and assignes all his
estate personale that he shall have in his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when
ever the same shall be lawfully required &c.
