Thereupon the said Jeffry Long with Daniel Long Sen. and Samuel Long of Maryland his Security, both of Somerset County planters all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto the said Sewel Long in the sum of one hundred pound Sterling of their several goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Joyntly and Severally to the use of the said Sewel Long his heirs and assigns to be made and levied. If it happen that the aforesaid Jeffry Long do not comply with the Laws in Relation to the Guardianship aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Sewel Long his heirs and assigns all his Estate personal that he shall have in his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be Legally Required &c.
