John Holloway } alias Shaw being four years of age next Christmas day. the said Michael Taylor ad.

Shaw to serve his said master John Holloway the full term aforesaid, during which term the said Michael Taylor ad. Shaw well and faithfully shall serve his secrets keep, his Commandments Lawfully and Honestly every where willing shall do and in all things as a good and faithful Servant shall demean himselfe toward his said master and all his during the term aforesaid &c. —

In Consideration of which Service the said John Holloway present here in Court in his proper person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court, in Court Individually sitting on behalf of the said Michael Taylor ad. Shaw that he the said John Holloway during the term aforesaid will Learn his said apprentice the trade of Sawcever and to Read write and Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive, and at the Expiration of his Servitude give his said apprentice anow suit of Cloaths over and above his Common wearing Cloaths and Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing, and all other Necessarys sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c. —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said John Holloway give Security for to Comply with the Covenants aforesaid — Thereupon the said John Holloway with George Boston of Somerset County planter his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly Indebted unto the said Michael Taylor ad. Shaw in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their severall goods and Chattells Land and Tenements Jointly and Severally to be made and Levied to the Use of the said Michael Taylor ad. Shaw.

If it Happen that the said John Holloway do not during the term of Servitude aforesaid Learn his said apprentice the Trade of Sawcever and to read write and Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive, and at the Expiration of his Servitude do not give him anow suit of Cloaths over and above his Common wearing Cloaths and do not Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing and all other Necessarys sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c. —

Quash an negro ~~boy~~ of John Britts being very ailing and distempred, is discharged from paying of Taxes until such time as please God to Restore him to his health againe &c. —
