The petitioner aforesaid being Read and heard and fully understood Wherefore it is considered that a Commission issue to the aforesaid Hugh Nelson as by the petition aforesaid is prayed and that James Martin Edward Round John Scambray and Adam Spence Ind. all of Somerset County gentle be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided for. —

Rachel White a poor child that liveth neither father and mother to take care of her is bound by the Court unto Mary Stilley of Somerset County wife to an other at the age of Sixteen years the said Rachelle White being four years old the fourteenth day of May last the said Rachelle White to serve her said mistress the full term aforesaid during which term the said Rachelle White her said mistress well and faithfully shall serve her Secrets keep her commandments Lawfully and Honestly every where willingly shall do and in all things as a good and faithfull servant shall demean herself towards her said mistress and all hers during the term aforesaid &c. —

In consideration of which Service the said Mary Stilley present here in Court in her person covenanted with the Justices of the same Court, in Court Judicially Sitting on behalf of the said Rachael White that she the said Mary Stilley during the term aforesaid will teach her said apprentice to Read well in the Bible and Knitt Sew and Spin and other housewifery and Likewise find and provide for her said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing and all other necessaries sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c. —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Mary Stilley give a security for to comply with the Covenants aforesaid — Thereupon the said Mary Stilley with John Dennis Ind. her security both present herein Court in their proper persons and acknowledged and themselves indebted under the said
