for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term of yr. —————

Ordered by the Court here that all the Male Taxables between Wickneys branch and the  
the great bridge over the head of Powomoke River be added as Labourers to Mr. Edmond  
Hough Overseer of the Road in the Indian Town &c.

Stanton Adkins Appointed Overseer of the Road in Boquetown Hundred and the  
head of Samuel Tresitt &c. —————

Lambo anegro boy of John Gales is adjudged by the Court to the age of fourteen Years &  
Charles Brandon a servant Boy of George Borman. Ind. Imported into this Country in the Ship  
called the Tryal Capt. Pinners Commander of said Ship is adjudged by the Court to the  
age of fourteen Years this term &c. —————

Jenny anegro girl of George Borman Ind. is adjudged by the Court to the age of Twelve Years  
this term &c. —————

Upon the petition of Charles Ballard Overseer of the Road down the Neck between  
Whitsonomolo and Manning for to have all the Male Taxables added to him that Live on the  
South side of the said Neck nowitt, Thomas Durhams, Thomas Goungton John Dorman, John  
Leathorbury and Henry Dorman's families which is to him granted and it is ordered by the  
Court that the said Charles Ballard be Overseer of the Road as formerly and that he keep further  
the Road that Leads up the middle of the Neck and that he keep the wileh bridge in  
good Repair &c.

Sam Jarvis a mollatto boy born of a pertani Mollatto Woman named Moll Jarvis  
aged about Six months is sold by the Court according to act of assembly in such case made  
and provided unto Mr. Alie Alie her heirs and assigns until he arrives at the age of  
thirty one years. In Consideration of which sale and Service William Houghton of  
Somerset County hath presented here in Court undertakes and promiseth on behalfe of the said Alie Alie  
to pay to the use of the County of five hundred pounds of tobacco at a next County Court for not to be  
allowed any thing for keeping of said Mollatto Boy for the time past &c.
