Whereupon the said Sarah Staples with Francis Borter her security both present here in Court in their proper persons and acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in ten pounds Sterling each of their severall goods and Chattell Lands and tenements to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Assignors to be made and Levied. If it happen that the said Sarah Staples do not make her personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Widning Creek the third wedday of November next, and do not answer unto his Lordship of and concerning the presentment affo, and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon, and do depart the same Court without Leave thereof.

The Same --- Andrew Thompson appears according to his Recognizance for his good behaviour and appearance at this Court and he and his security is accordingly discharged from the same Recognizance &c. hereupon the said Andrew Thompson is ordered to give new Recognizance for his good behaviour and appearance at November Court next with two Security &c.

Whereupon the said Andrew Thompson with William Catlin and Edward Hule of Somerset County planters his Securitys all present here in Court acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Andrew Thompson in ten pounds Sterling and the said William Catlin and Edward Hule in five pounds Sterling each of their severall goods and Chattell Lands and tenements of Every of them to the use of the said Lord Proprietary his heirs and Assignors to be made and Levied.

If it happen that the said Andrew Thompson do not make his personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Widning Creek the third wedday of November next and do not answer unto his said Lordship of such matters as shall be objected against him and do depart the same Court without Leave thereof and in the mean time if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people &c.
