Displeasure of Almighty God and to the evil Example of all others in such Cases
offending and Against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided
wherefore the Said Rob. Jenkins Henry pray the Advice of the Court in y^e
Promises and Due process of Law thereon Against the Said Honour Daley may
Issue. — Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said

Honour Daley if he to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the twenty fifth day of August and Dow: One thousand.
Seven Hundred and thirty three came here into Court before the Justice, the said Honour Daley in her proper person
and had alowing of the Information, and Says that of the premises, and as by the Information of above
upon her Imposed she is guilty thereof and Confesseth that Jupiter a negro man belonging to
a certain Jonathan Stanton is the begetter of the Child she stands Imposed against &c.

And forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court that the Child of the said Honour Daley is
a mullatto Child and a female, and whereas there is due to Somerset County for such Inordinate
Copulation Seven Years Service from the said Honour, and thirty One Year Service from the said
Child. according to an Act of Assembly in such Case provided &c.

Whereupon the Justice had according to the said Act of Assembly did Sell the said female
Mullatto Child which is called Sarah (so as she begett of the same Honour) unto a certain Wm
Gray of Manoran, until she arrives at the age of thirty One, the said Mullatto Child called Sarah
being One month old the twenty fourth day of this Instant, and to serve the said William Gray
her Master his heirs or assigns the full term of time aforesaid. In consideration of which Sale and
Service the said William Gray present here in Court undertakes for to pay to the Use of the County
aforesaid five hundred pounds of Tobacco &c.
