Displeasure of Almighty God and to the evil Example of all others in such Cases
Offending and Against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided
wherefore the Said Rob. Jenkins Henry pray the Advice of the Court in y^e
Promised and Due process of Law therefore Against the Said Honourable Henry may
Proceed. — Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take the said
Honourable Henry if he doth answer & and afterwards to witt the twenty fifth day of August and Dated One thousand
Seven Hundred and Ninety three came before the Justice, the said Honourable Henry in her proper person
and had alsways of the Information, and says that of the premises and as by the Information above
upon her Imposed she is guilty thereof and confesseth that Jupiter a negro man belonging to
a certain Jonathan Stanton is the begetter of the Child she stands informed against her.

And forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court that the Child of the aforesaid Honourable Henry is
a mulatto Child and a female, and whereas there is due to Somerset County for such Inordinate
Population Seven Years Service from the said Honour, and Ninety One Years Service from the aforesaid
Child according to Law of Assembly in such Case provided.

Whereupon the Justice had according to the aforesaid act of Assembly did Sell the aforesaid female
mulatto Child which is called Sarah (so as aforesaid begott of the same Honour) unto a certain Willm
Gray of Manors until she arrives at the age of Ninety One, the said mulatto Child called Sarah
being one month old the twenty fourth day of this instant, and to serve the said Willm Gray
her master his heirs or assigns the full term of time aforesaid. In consideration of which sale and
service the said Willm Gray present here in Court undertaken for to pay to the use of the County
of five hundred pounds of tobacco the

Somerset to Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces
of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Balt^r To the Sheriff of
Somerset County Greeting we command you that you attack any the Goods
Cattels Rights or Credits of Rob^r Holland late of Somerset County Merchant
if they shall be found in your Balywick to the Value of one hundred and
three pounds Sixteen Shillings and two pence Current money and Two thousand
pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same Attacked or any part thereof
that same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our
Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third
