Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly

or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Rob<sup>t</sup>. Bolton in a plea of  
Trespast upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men  
of your Balgwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose  
hand you make know the said Attachment that he she or they be and  
appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show  
Cause if any he she or they have why the said Good Chattles Right or Credits so  
Attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution  
thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provide  
if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt  
that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have  
you then and there this writt Witness Rob<sup>t</sup>. King Gent Chief Justice of our said  
Court the Twentysifth day of June In the Nineteenth year of our Dom<sup>o</sup>. G<sup>o</sup>.  
Anno Dom<sup>o</sup>. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Three.

to show C<sup>o</sup>. and further certify that I have Attached of the Goods  
and Chattles of the aforesaid Rob<sup>t</sup>. Holland to the value of Twelve pounds  
Nineteen Shillings and three pence as by a schedule to the aforesaid writt  
Annexed as by the within writt I am commanded so answer
