Whereupon the said George Howard garnishee of the said Robert Holland altho' solemnly called Cometh  
not but makes default.

Thereupon the said Robert Bolton <sup>upon giving Security and not to act separately</sup> by his attorney <sup>prays</sup> that the said  
One thousand pounds of tobacco and the severall pieces of Coopers ware of the value of Twelve  
pounds Nineteen Shillings and three pence current money so as aforesaid attached may be condemned as of  
the Rights and Credits of the said Robert Holland towards Satisfying unto the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton his Damages  
and costs and Charges incurred by means of the attachment aforesaid.

Whereupon a certain Hutton Hill of Somerset County planter present herein Court undertakes for the  
said Robert Bolton avowing to act of assembly that if in case the said Robert Holland do at any time  
within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Robert Bolton Claim against him.  
to be satisfied or otherwise to be undue before the laying of the attachment and that then he the said Robert  
Bolton shall make Restitution unto him the said Robert Holland of all or such part thereof as shall  
be made appear to be undue as aforesaid or that he the said Hutton Hill will do it for him.

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said One thousand pounds of tobacco so as  
aforesaid attached in the hands of the said George Howard be condemned as of the Rights and Credits of  
the said Robert Holland towards Satisfying unto the said Robert Bolton his Damages aforesaid  
and all costs accruing upon the attachment aforesaid and that the said Robert Bolton have thereof 1/2<sup>nd</sup> p<sup>ts</sup>.

Therefore it is considered that the said Several pieces of Coopers ware of the value of  
Twelve pounds Nineteen Shillings and three pence current money so as aforesaid attached be  
condemned as the goods and Chattell of the said Robert Holland towards Satisfying unto the  
said Robert Bolton his Damages and all costs accruing upon the writt of attachment aforesaid and  
that he have thereof 3/4<sup>th</sup> p<sup>ts</sup>.
