And Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the aforesaid James Timmons and Aaron Timmons that they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Crook the third Tuesday of June next to show Cause if any thing for themselves they have or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid Joseph his Execution of the Judgment aforesaid Against them According to the form of the Recovery aforesaid ought not to have if to them it shall seem Expedient &c. at which said third Tuesday of June to wit the Twentieth day of the said Month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset held at Dividing Crook in the County aforesaid and the aforesaid Joseph Jones by Francis Allen his Attorney and the Sher of Somerset County to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent. at the said day returned that by Virtue of the writ aforesaid he had made known unto the aforesaid James Timmons one of the Defs. by Joshua Merrill and John Dod Honest and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick that he be and appear before our Justices of our County Court aforesaid at the Day and place aforesaid to show &c. as to him it was Commanded, And further the same Sher returned at the said Day that the aforesaid Aaron Timmons the other of the Defs. had nothing In his Bailiwick whereby to him he could make known unto him nor is found in the same and the aforesaid Aaron Timmons Cometh not therefore Command is again Given to the Sher of Somerset County that by Honest and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known unto the said Aaron Timmons that he should be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Crook the third Tuesday of August next to show Cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid Joseph his Execution of the Judgment aforesaid Against him According to the form of the Recovery aforesaid he ought not to have if unto him it should seem Expedient and that he should have then and there the Names of them before whom to him he should make known and this writ Witness Robt King Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty fifth day of June in the Ninth year of our said King Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three
