The aforesaid **Richard Waters** by their Attorneys aforesaid and thereupon the said Richard says that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Samuel Reah nor can he say but that he did a p[er]me upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid above against him hath complained and as to the Damages of the said Samuel by him by Occasion of the promises in that part sustained the said Richd says and Confesseth that the aforesaid Samuel has sustained Damages by Occasion of the promises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to five pounds twelve Shillings and two pence half penny and not more and because the aforesaid Samuel says not this but the same Allegation Confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those Damages above Confessed and his Costs and Charges aforesaid to him adjudged &c. Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is ordered that the aforesaid Samuel recover against the aforesaid **Richard Waters** his Damages aforesaid to the aforesaid five pounds twelve Shillings and two pence half penny ^{Law full money of America} by the said **Richd** in form aforesaid Confessed as also from hundred and one ^{--- pounds of Tob.} for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the said Samuel at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties aforesaid. Adjudged and the aforesaid **Richd** in Mercy &c.

Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County by his writ in those words following viz

Somerset County **Charles** absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Barron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County Greeting we Command you that you Attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of James Emra late of Somerset County Merchant if they shall be found in your Balgwick to the value of two pounds twelve Shillings Lawd money of America and five hundred and fifty pounds of Tob. and when you have the same Attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody Safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Balgwick to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tueday of March next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the use of certain Thomas Blewitt unless the said James Emra by himself or his Attorneys shall appear and answer unto the said **Thos Blewitt** in a plea of Trespas Upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull moe of your Balgwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they do and appear before the Justices of our County Court to be held aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights ^{or Credits} so Attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ Witness Robt King Govt. Chief Justice of our said Court the ^{Eighth} Tueday of Novemb. in the ^{Eight} Year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini 1732
