 John Demys not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true prays Judgment
 for those Damages above Confest and his Cost and Charges afo. To him a Judge
 Therefore by Consent of the parties afo. it is Considered that the afo. John Caldwell
 Recover against the aforesaid Susannah Wordie his Damages afo. to the afo.
 Nineteen pounds Curr money of Maryland or three thousand Eight hundred
 pounds of ¹⁰⁰ by the same Susannah in form afo. Confessd as also three hundred
 pounds of ¹⁰⁰ for his Cost and Charges
 afo. to the same John at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties
 afo. a Judge and the afo. Susannah in Mercy.
