Capi Corpus, Joshua Caldwell Sheriff — And the said Walter Taylor by James Shirley his Attorney (and said Defendant) the force and Injury whereof and prays Leave thereof to Imparle here untill next Court and he hath it and the said day is given to the afores. Dunkin Murray here also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the Nineteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the afores. Dunkin Murray in his proper person as the afores. Walter Taylor by his Attorney afores. and thereupon the said Walter prays further Leave thereof to Imparle here untill next Court and he hath it and the said day is given to the afores. Dunkin Murray here also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the Twenty first day of August Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the afores. Dunkin Murray in his proper person as the afores. Walter Taylor by his Attorney aforesaid. And thereupon the said Walter Taylor offers himself against the said Dunkin Murray in the place afores. but the said Dunkin Murray altho' solemnly called comes not nor is his writt afores. further prosecuted against the said Walter Taylor &c.

Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in Mercy, the self. name pledged &c. and that the afores. Walter Taylor go thereof without day, also it is considered that the aforesaid Walter Taylor recover against the afores. Dunkin Murray his Damages by Occasion of the promises to One hundred and Sixty Nine — pounds of Tobacco to the said Walter by Discretion of the Justice here at his request for his Cost and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute &c. By the Court here adjudged &c.
