Dividing Court the third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto W^m Coe of a plea of Trespass upon the Case &c. And that thereof heretofore not fail &c.

Whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his Attorney complains against the said Rob^t in the plea aforesaid as follows Viz^t ---
Somerset County ss. Rob^t Hall and late of Somerset County Merchant was attached to answer unto W^m Coe of a plea of Trespass upon the Case &c.

And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his Attorney complains that whereas the said Rob^t after the first Day of May Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and five to wit on the thirty first Day of May Seventeen hundred and thirty two at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court made his certain Note in Writing called a promissory Note with his proper hand subscribed bearing Date the same Day and Year last mentioned and that said Note to the said William then and there did deliver by which said Note the said Rob^t did promise and Oblige himself his heirs and assigns to pay or Cause to be paid unto the said William the Sum of Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings proper Money of Pennsylvania (being of the Value of Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings Curr^t Money of Maryland) at or before the thirty first Day of July next ensuing the Date of the said Note and by Reason thereof as also by force of the Statute in such Cases lately made and provided the said Rob^t became chargeable to pay to the said William the aforesaid Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings according to the Tenor of the said Note and so being chargeable the said Rob^t in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the aforesaid thirty first Day of May in the Year Seventeen hundred and thirty two aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself did assume and to the said William then and there did faithfully promise to pay the aforesaid Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings according to the Tenor of the said Note and altho the said Rob^t two pounds Eighteen Shillings and five pence parcel of the aforesaid Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings to the said William he hath paid and satisfied yet as to the aforesaid Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings and seven pence residue of the aforesaid Sixteen pounds Ten Shillings the aforesaid Rob^t his promise and Assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the said W^m in that part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said thirteen pounds Eleven Shillings and seven pence Residue as aforesaid to the said W^m according to the Tenor of the said Note hath not paid or Contented Altho the same to do the said Rob^t by the said William afterwards to wit on the thirty first Day of July in the Year last aforesaid and often afterwards at Somerset County aforesaid he was therunto Requested but the same to him hitherto to pay or Contented hath refused and still doth refuse and Done to the Damage of the said William of Twenty Seven pounds three Shillings and four pence Curr^t Money of Maryland and thereupon he brings Suit &c.
