William Lord by his Attorney Aps. and the Sher of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was Directed Likewise comes and Makes Return thereof to the Court here Chosen vizt Non Est Inventus Short note left &c. . . . Joshua Caldwell Sher

Whereupon the said William Lord by his Attorney aforesaid prays that forasmuch as that he has complied with the Law In order to an Attachment he may have Judgment against the said Robt Holland for his Damages as by way of Attachment According to Act of Assembly &c.

Whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said William Lord has complied with the Law as alleged Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said William Lord Recover agt the aforesaid Robt Holland the sum of thirteen pounds Eleven Shillings and seven pence Current Money of Maryland his Damages by Occasion of the promises aforesaid. Also all Costs and Charges by the said self laid out and Expended about his writs by way of Attachment Against the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said Robt Holland According to Act of Assembly in such Case Made and provided &c.

F.A The same Command was Given to the Sher of Somerset County that he should take Robt Holland late of Somerset County Merch. if he should be found in his Bailwick and him should safe keep so that he should have his Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividingbrook the Third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto W. Lord of a plea of Troppass upon the Case. And that thereof he should not fail &c.

Whereupon the said Wm by Francis Allen his Attorney complains Against the aforesaid Robt In the plea aforesaid as follows vizt
Somerset County Robt Holland late of Somerset County Merch was Attached to answer unto William Lord of a plea of Troppass upon the Case &c.

And Whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his Attorney complains that Whereas the said Robt the first day of May Anno Dom 1700 or there abouts and thirty three At the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of the Court was Indebted unto the said Wm in seven pounds Eleven Shill and three pence Current Money of Maryland for sundry properly Chargeable in Debt. as by Act thereof herunto annexed May in full appear And being so Indebted the said Robt in Consideration thereof the day and Year aforesaid at the place aforesaid Upon himself did assume and to the said William then and there did faithfully Promise that he the said Robt his aforesaid seven pounds Eleven Shillings and three pence to the said William when he should be afterwards thereunto Requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content. Never the less the said Robt his promise and Assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid Made. Nothing Regarding but Plotting and fraudulently Intending the said William in that part Craftily and Subtly to deceive and Defraud the said seven pounds Eleven Shill and three pence to the said William altho the same to Do the said Robt by the aforesaid William on the (afo)
