Command was Given to the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County
 that he should take James Shirley Gent out of the Attorneys of
 Somerset County Court if he should be found in his Balivick and him
 should safe keep so that he might have his Body before Justices of his Lordships County
 Court of Somerset to be held at Diving Crook the third Tuesday of August then next
 to satisfy Rob^t Watson of four pound in Cash and Eight pound in Tob^o. at Twelve shill^{ings}
 and six pence of hundred and three hundred and thirty two pound of Tob^o which to the said
 Rob^t in the same Court before the Justice thereof at Diving Crook in the County afo^{re} was
 adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of a certain Promise and Assumption
 to the said Rob^t by the afo^{re} James made and not performed where of the said James is
 Convicted.

At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the Twenty first Day of
 the same Month Anno Domⁱⁿⁱ One thousand seven hundred and thirty three being
 the day of the Return of the same Writ came the afo^{re} Rob^t Watson by Francis Allen
 his Attorney and the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County then being to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent
 at the same Day returned upon the writ afo^{re} that he by Virtue of the said writ to him
 directed took the Body of the afo^{re} James Shirley whose Body before his Lordships
 Justices at the day and place afo^{re} in the writ afo^{re} mentioned he had there ready &
 Thereupon the said James Shirley prostrated here in Court at the prayer of the afo^{re}
 Rob^t Watson by his Attorney afo^{re} is committed into the Custody of the Sher^{iff} of the said
 County there to Remain until the said Rob^t of the Damages afo^{re} shall
 be fully satisfied & the said Sher^{iff} to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent present here
 in Court took Charge of the said James Shirley accordingly
