And whereupon The said Thomas Nevett by Francis Allen his Attorney saith that whereas the said Thomas Glaster the Ninth day of September Anno Dom. Seventeen hundred and thirty two at the County of Somerset afo. within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory which the said Thomas Nevett with the Seal of the said Tho. Glaster signed here into Court brings the date whereof is the said day and year did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said Thomas Nevett in the afo. five pounds to be paid unto the said Thomas Nevett when he should be thereunto Required yett the said Thomas Glaster tho' often Required the said five pounds to the afo. Thomas Nevett hath not as yett Rendered but the said to him hitherto to Render hath denyed and still doth Do by and Unjustly - Obtain to the Damage of the said Thomas of three pound money afo. And thereupon he brings Suit &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Glaster present herein Court in his proper person at the prayer of the said Thomas Nevett by his attorney afo. is adjudged by the Court here to give Special Bail to the action afo. but for want hereof the said Thomas Glaster is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to Remain &c. The said Sheriff to witt Joshua Redwell Gent: present herein Court in his proper person took Charge of the said Thomas Glaster accordingly &c.

Thereupon the said Thomas Glaster in his proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and says that he cannot gain say the action afo. of the afo. Thomas Nevett nor can he say but that the Writing Obligatory afo. is the deed of him the said Thomas Glaster - nor but that he owes the same Thomas Nevett the afo. five pound in manner and form as the aforesaid Thomas Nevett above against him declared -

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Thomas Nevett recover against the afo. Thomas Glaster his debt afo. and his damages Sustained by Quasion of the detaining of the same Debt to two hundred and ^{two} fifty pounds of tobacco to the same Thomas Nevett of his afo. by the Court here adjudged and the afo. Thomas Glaster in many &c. - afterwards to witt the twenty first day of August and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three the said Thomas Glaster present herein Court at the prayer of the afo. Thomas Nevett by his attorney afo. is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to Remain until the said Thomas Nevett of the debt and damages afo. should be fully Satisfied the said Sheriff to witt Joshua Redwell - Gent: present herein Court took Charge of the said Thomas Glaster accordingly &c.
