And Whereas the said Tho'

prays that forasmuch as he has complied with the Law in order to an
Attachment he may have Judgment against the said Nath^l Hoche James
Peirce and John Wood Adm^s as afd for his Damages afd by way of Attachment
according to Act of Assembly &c. Whereupon for that it shew to the Court here
that the afd Thomas Fletcher hath complied with the Law as alleged &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afd Tho' Fletcher
Recover against the afd Nath^l Hoche James Peirce and John Wood Adm^s of the
afd Hugh Arbuthnot Dd^r his Damages afd to the afd fifty eight pounds four
Shill^s and three pence Ster^l money of Great Britain as also all Costs and Charges by
the said Plf^t laid out and expended by way of Attachment against the goods chattels
Rights or Credits of the afd Hugh Arbuthnot Dd^r (at the time of his Death remaining
to be administered) according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided &c.

Ordered by the Court here that Edmund Dickerson Sen^r pay unto Daniel Townsend one hundred
and Twenty pounds of Tob^o being due unto him for his attendance four days as an Evidence on behalf
of his ~~Wife~~ ^{Wife} against Edmund Dickerson he having made Oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court here that Edm^d Dickerson Sen^r pay unto Charles Dickerson one hundred
and Twenty pounds of Tob^o being due unto him for his wife's Attendance four days as an Evidence
on behalf of his ~~Wife~~ ^{Wife} against the said Edm^d Dickerson the having made Oath to the
same &c.
