 of Somerset County Planter at did William Hearn of Somerset County in the Province of
 Maryland Planter as well ascertain Debt of five thousand seven hundred and forty four
 pounds of Tob.^o as three hundred and twenty one pounds of Tob.^o which to the said Thomas
 same Court were Adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of the Detaining
 of the same Debt whereof he is Complainant as by the Record and proceedings thereof in
 our same Court before our Justices at Dividing Creek Remained manifestly Apparent
 Nevertheless Execution of the Judgment as yet Remained to be made and the aff.
 Tho^o Layfield is since Dead as by the Immination of Cathrine Layfield & George Layfield
 Executors of the Testament and Last will of the aff. Thomas who have roved and because
 we will that those things which in our same Court are Rightfully Acted Ought to be
 duly Executed. We Command you that by honest and Lawfull men of your Ballywick you
 make known unto the said William Hearn that he be and appear before our Justices
 of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the Third Tuesday of August
 next to shew Cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore
 the aff. Cathrine and George should not have their Execution against him of the
 Debt and Damages aff. According to the form of the Recovery aff. if unto him it
 shall seem Expedient and have you then and there the Names of them by whom
 to him you make known and this writt Witness Rob^t King Gent^l Chief Justice
 of our said Court the twenty fifth day of June in the 1st Year of our Dominion
 Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three.

Tuesday of August to wit the twenty first day of the same Month Anno Domini one
 thousand seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships Court
 of Somerset held at Dividing Creek in the County aff. Came the aff. Cathrine Layfield and
 George Layfield & Co. as aff. by Francis Allen their Attorney aff. and the Sheriff of said
 County to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent^l at the same Day Returned that he by Virtue of the
 Writt aff. to him directed had made known unto the aff. William Hearn by John Doe
 and Rich^d Roe honest and Lawfull men of his Ballywick that he be and appear before
 his said Lordships Justices the day and place aff. to shew Cause as within to him it was
 Comanded and the said William Hearn so forewarned and at the same Day being
 solemnly called someth not but makes default therefore it is Considered that the aff. Cathrine
 Layfield and George Layfield have Execution against the said William Hearn of the
 Debt and Damages aff. According to the force form and Effect of the Recovery aff.
