Maryland p^{ro} Daniel Dulany Esq. his Lordships attorney Gen^l of this province of Maryland To all To Whome these presents shall come greeting Know Ye that for the Especial Trust and Confidence I have in the diligence Care and Circumspection of William Goules borough of Talbott County Gent. and of his Skill and Knowledge in the Laws & Customs of Great Brittain and of this province have made deputed and appointed and by these presents do make depute and appoint the said William Goules borough to be Clerk of the Indictments and prosecutor of all his Lordships pleas, suits and actions within the County of Somerset in the said province To have and exercise and Enjoye the said Office of Clerk of the Indictments of the said County with all priviledges fees Perquisites and profits therunto belonging as fully and amply as any Clerk of the Indictments heretofore had or ought to have to him the said William during pleasure given under my hand and Seal this twelfth day of October and in 1733 in the nineteenth Year of his said Lordships Dominion &c

Which being read and heard the said William Goules borough present himself in Court at his prayer is admitted prosecutor of his Lordships pleas in the County aforesaid and Likewise to practise as attorney in the same Court in taking the several Oaths appointed by act of assembly to be taken to the Government with the oath of prosecutor and attorney and subscribed the oath of abjuration and test.
