Ordered that John Wilson be allowed one hundred and five pounds of tobacco by the Year for the keeping and maintaining for
John David Redmon an Orphan and finding him in provision Clothing and all other necessities as may be sufficient
for such an object &c

Robert French - Whereas aforesaid Robert French an Orphan being formerly bound by Somerset County Court
bound to John Reddish ... to aforesaid John Venables for to Learn him the trade of a Cooper & and forasmuch as it doth
appear to this Court here that the said Robert French was so sickly and weak of body that it
was impossible for him to Learn the trade aforesaid. Whereupon the said John Venables Master of the aforesaid Robert French
and his Security are discharged from his recognisance aforesaid entered into for to Learn of the said Robert French the trade aforesaid
and Likewise the guardianship of the aforesaid Robert French the same

Whereupon the said Robert French Orphan aforesaid makes choice of aforesaid John Reddish as his guardian
who is approved of by this Court and Ordered that the said John Reddish take unto his hands, possession and care all
the aforesaid Robert French and all his Estate Real and personal until the said French come to age to take the same
and Likewise it is Ordered that the aforesaid John Venables, the former guardian deliver up unto the aforesaid John Reddish
now guardian all the Estate of the said Frenches that he hath in his hands both Real and personal &c

further it is ordered and agreed by and Between the Justices of Somerset County Court in Court Judicialy
Sitting and the said John Reddish, that he the said John Reddish will during the guardianship aforesaid give the
said Robert French a good Schoolling and Sufficient meat drink washing and Lodging and Cloathing during the time
aforesaid and give security for to comply with the guardianship aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said John Reddish with Henry Toadman and Moses Driskill both of Somerset County plan-
ter his Security & all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to be Indeb-
ted unto the said Robert French in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their severall goods and chattels
Lands and tenements jointly and severally to the use of the said Robert French his heirs and assignees to be
made and levied if it shall appear that the aforesaid John Reddish do not comply with the Law in Relation to
the guardianship aforesaid and do not during the guardianship aforesaid give the said Robert French One whole
Year Schoolling and Lodging and provide for the said French during the time aforesaid Sufficient meat
drink washing Lodging and Cloathing meat for him to have and wear - and do not deliver up unto the
said French his heirs and assignees all his Estate Real and personal that he shall have in his hands and
possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be legally required for -
