and his Family are discharged from the Discharge afo Entered into for to Learn said Robert Frouch the trade afo
and Likewise the Guardian ship of the afo Robert Frouch &c. —

Whereupon the said Robert Frouch Orphan afo makes choice of a certain John Reddish as his Guardian
who is approved of by the Court and ordered that the said John Reddish take into his hands possession and care
the afo Robert Frouch and all his Estate Reale and personall until the said Frouch come to age to take the same
and Likewise it is ordered that the afo John Venables the former Guardian deliver up unto the afo John Reddish
now Guardian all the Estate of the said Frouches that he hath in his hands both Reale and personall &c. —

Further it is ordered and agreed by and Between the Justice of Somerset County Court in Court Individually
Sitting and the said John Reddish that he the said John Reddish will during the Guardian ship afo give the
said Robert Frouch a year Schooling and sufficient meat drink washing and Linnen and Clothing during the time
afo and give Bondy for to comply with the Guardian ship afo &c. —

Whereupon the said John Reddish with Henry Toadonie and Moses Driskill both of Somerset County plan
ter his Family all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to be Indeb
ted unto the said Robert Frouch in the Sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their Several goods and Chattels
Lands and tenements Joyntly and Severally to the use of the said Robert Frouch his heirs and assigns to be
made and Levied If it happen that the afo John Reddish do not comply with the Law in Relation to
the Guardian ship afo. and do not during the Guardian ship afo give the said Robert Frouch one whole
year Schooling and Likewise find and provide for the said Frouch during the time afo sufficient meat
drink washing Linnen and Clothing meat for him to have and wear. and do not deliver up unto the
said Frouch his heirs and assigns all his Estate Reale and personall that he shall have in his hands and
possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be Legally required &c. —
