In consideration of which Service the said Arthur Dashiell present here in Court in his proper  
person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in Court Individually sitting on behalfe of the said Ed<sup>d</sup>  
North, that he the said Arthur Dashiell during the term afo<sup>r</sup> will Learn his said apprentice arithmetick as far  
as the rule of three Inclusive, and the art of Navigation as far as may be Sufficient to Navigate a  
Vessel aloft the Sea from one port to another. and at the Expiration of his servitude give him a square  
-ter Scale, a pair of Dividers, a mariners Callender, a quadrant, and a new suit of Cloaths over  
above his Common wearing Cloaths, and Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing  
Lodging and Cloathing Sufficient for him to have and wear during the time of his servitude afo<sup>r</sup> &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the afo<sup>r</sup> Arthur Dashiell Give Recognizance with  
one Surety for to Comply with the Covenants afo<sup>r</sup> &c.

Thereupon the said Arthur Dashiell with Maj<sup>r</sup> George Dashiell his Surety both present here  
in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to be Indebted unto the said Edward North  
the younger in the Sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their body's goods or Chattells Lands or tenements  
Jointly and Severally to the use of the said Edward North his heirs or assignes to be made and  
-Lied if it happen that the aforesaid Arthur Dashiell do not during the term afo<sup>r</sup> Learn his said  
apprentice arithmetick as far as the rule of three Inclusive, and the art of Navigation as

Callender, a quadrant and a new suit of Cloaths over and above his Common wearing Cloaths, and  
do not Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing Sufficient  
for him to have and wear during the time of his servitude afo<sup>r</sup> &c.
