Is actually gone or run away and is about to remove his Effects out of this County to Dissolve his Creditors You are hereby Required to Issue an Attachment on behalf of John Dearbrough for the Sum as in the Account here sent You proceed with the precedent Costs and Charges — According to the form of an Act of Assembly in such Case lately Made and provided and for your Doing this shall be your Warrant Witness my hand this Twenty fourth Day of March Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and thirty Two
To Thomas Hayward Esq of Somerset County — In Scott

Pursuant to an act of assembly of this province now in force, and in obedience to the above said warrant the following attachment was issued against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said Samuel Waterhouse the tenor of which will followeth in these words viz. —

Somerset Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Samuel Waterhouse late of Somerset County manner if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Eleven Shillings and five pence and three hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of certain John Dearbrough according to act of assembly and that by good and Lawful men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be hold as aforesaid show Cause if any had or they have why the said Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and Made according to act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem most and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices before whom you make the same known at the said day and place aforesaid And this Writ Witness Rob^t King Gent. Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty Second day of March in the Eighteenth year of our Dominion G^o. Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two.

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and Day. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset hold at Dwiding Creek in the County aforesaid came the said John Dearbrough in his own proper person and the Sher. of Somerset County to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent. at the same day Returned that by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had attached as the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of the said Samuel Waterhouse, in the hands of John Newbold twenty Six bushells of Indian Corn of the value of Eleven Shillings and five pence and three hundred pounds of Tobacco, and likewise that he had made known unto the said John Newbold by Richard Logwood and Walter Taylor honest and Lawful of his Bailiwick that he be and appear before his said
