shall be found in your daily walk to the value of Eleven shillings and five pence and three hundred pounds
of tobacco and when you have the same attacched or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep
so that you have the same before our Justices of Our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidg Creek
the third Tuesday affire next them and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to end for the debts
of aforesd John Earbrough according to act of Assembly and that by good and Lawfull men of our
County you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attacched
that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of Our County Court of Somerset to be held as aforesaid
show cause if any hechtor they have why the said Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so
attacched in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Executed herof he
and Made according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them
it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto our
said Justices before whome you make the same known at thid said day and place aforesaid
