their fees due by occasion of the premises &c, thereupon a certain George Trevitt Son of Philip -
Trevitt present here in Court undertakes for the said William Davis for to pay the severall Officers their fees
due by occasion of the premises &c.

His Lordship } Nehemiah Holland and Philip Taylor both of Somerset County planters appears
herewith according to a certain Recognizance Entered into for their good behaviour.
and appearance at this Court and thereupon the said Nehemiah Holland and Philip
Taylor and their Sureties are accordingly discharged. and thereupon the said Philip
Taylor is ordered to give Security for the severall Officers their fees due by occasion of the premises
thereupon the said Nehemiah Holland present here in Court undertakes for the said Philip Taylor
to pay the severall Officers fees due as aforesaid.

present here in Court is ordered to give Recognizance for his appearance at next
