next and do not answer unto his said Lordship concerning what should be objected against him on his said
Lordships behalfe and do not depart the same Court without leave there and is not in the mean time of
his good behaviour to all his Lordships good people then he —

His Lordship William Davis appears according to his Recognizance for the good behaviour to this
William Davis Court and is discharged therefrom, and is ordered to give security for the several officers
their fees due by question of the premises afft, whereupon a certain George Trevitt son of Philip —
Trevitt present herein Court undertakes for the said William Davis for to pay the several Officers their fees
due by question of the premises afft. —

His Lordship Nehemiah Holland and Philip Taylor both of Somerset County planters appear
Nehemiah Holland & here in Court according to a certain Recognizance entered into for their good behaviour.
Philip Taylor and appearance at this Court and whereupon the said Nehemiah Holland and Philip
Taylor and their security are accordingly discharged. and whereupon the said Philip
Taylor is ordered to give security for the several Officers their fees due by question of the premises
whereupon the aforesaid Nehemiah Holland present herein Court undertakes for the said Philip Taylor
to pay the several Officers fees due as aforesaid.

His Lordship Whereas a certain Isajah Bredale being informed against to this Court that he had
Isajah Bredale brought two Negroes into this County contrary to Law &c. the said Isajah Bredale
present here in Court is ordered to give Recognizance for his appearance at March
