Thereupon Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take the affd Sarah Staples of Stepney parish if she to answer her and afterwards hereto with the twentieth day of Nov: One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset then held at Bridgwater in and for the County and Cometh the affd Sarah Staples in her proper person according to a certain Recognizance by her and her pledges in that part before Consciente, and had a hearing of the presentment aforesaid and say that she is not thereof guilty and of this she putteth herself upon the Country and Robert Jenkinson Henry Gent. Clerk of the Judgments in and for the County affd who for his said Lordships in that part followeth likewise. — Whereupon the affd Robert Jenkinson Henry Gent. who for his said Lordships in that part prosecutes as to the bearing of the bastard Child in the presentment aforesaid mentioned Consciente that he will no further prosecute against the aforesaid Sarah Staples &c. Therefore it is considered that the affd Sarah Staples of the bearing of the bastard Child in the presentment affd be quiet and goeth of without daye Whereupon the aforesaid Sarah Staples is ordered by the Court here to give Security for the payment of the several Officers their fees due by reason of the premises, affd. Thereupon Francis Carter of Somerset County planter present herein Court undertaken for the said Sarah Staples for to paying the several Officers their fees due upon the premises affd her.

Catherine Carr appear according to her Recognizance for her appearance at the Court to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against Sarah Stagles, &c.

The same Mary Townsend appears herein Court according to her Recognizance to give Mary Townsend Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against Stephen Wmright and is accordingly discharged therefrom. Whereupon the said Mary Townsend is ordered to give New Security for her appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third day of March then next to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against the affd Stephen Wmright &c.

Whereupon the said Mary Townsend with William Smith of Somerset County planter for Security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his said Lordship the right honorable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their goods and Cattell Lands and tenements Separately to be made and Levied to the use of the said Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied if it happen that the affd Mary Townsend do not make her personal appearance before the Justices of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset
