person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had made (according to act of Assembly in such Case made and provided) if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this Writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and place aforesaid and have You then and there this Writt witness Robert King Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the Twentyfourth Day of August In the Nineteenth Year of our Dominion & Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Three ---

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the twentieth day of the same month and Year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came the said Woney M^r Gemney by Francis Allen his attorney and the Justices of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Gemeth and madath Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following vid. --- By virtue of the within writt to me directed to the Justices of Somerset County Court I do Certifie that on the fifteenth day of November One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three I did attach of the goods and Chattels of a certain Charles Redding to the Value of twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco and woonly stuffs for the Use of Woney M^r Gemney in the hands of Robert Geddes and I further Certifie that by John Dennis and Joshua Merritt good and Lawfull men of my Parish wick I have made known to the said Robert Geddes that he be and appear at the time and place appointed

Where upon the said Robert Geddes furnished of the aforesaid Charles Redding appears in his proper person and says that he cannot gain say but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said Charles Redding to the Value of One thousand pounds of Tobacco nor but that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the Use of the said Woney M^r Gemney as of the Rights and Credits of the said Charles Redding which the self doth not gain say. --- so answers --- J^d Caldwell Just.

Where upon the aforesaid Woney M^r Gemney by his attorney aforesaid prays that upon giving Security according to act of Assembly the aforesaid One thousand pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid Confessed by the aforesaid Robert Geddes furnished as aforesaid as of the Rights and Credits of the aforesaid Charles Redding may be condemned in the hands of the said Robert Geddes towards Satisfying to the said Woney M^r Gemney his damages and costs by means of the Suit aforesaid ---

There upon a certain William M^r Gemney of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertakes for the said Woney M^r Gemney that if in Case the said Charles Redding do at any time within year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Woney M^r Gemneys Claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be undue before the Laying of the attachment aforesaid that then the said Woney M^r Gemney shall make restitution unto the said Charles Redding of all or such part thereof as shall be so made appear to be undue as aforesaid or that he the said William Gemney will do the same for him ---

Therefore it is considered that the said Sum of One thousand pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid Confessed be condemned in the hands of the said Robert Geddes as of the Rights and Credits of the said Charles Redding towards Satisfying unto the said Woney M^r Gemney as well his damages by occasion of the premises aforesaid as also aforesaid costs and Charges answering by occasion of the attachment aforesaid and that the aforesaid Woney M^r Gemney have thereof a memorandum. The said Robert Geddes voluntarily takes his Oath that he hath not more of the Effects of the debts than that he has Confessed as aforesaid ---
