Whereupon the said William Hopkins in his proper person Comes and defends the force and Injury, when he and says that he cannot gain say the action of the said Thomas nor can he say but that he did apurise upon himselfe in such manner and form as the said Thomas above against him hath Complained and as to the Damage of the same Thomas by him by Occasion of the premises in that part sustained the said William Faith and Confesseth that the said Thomas hath Sustained Damage by Occasion of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part approved twelve pounds, Ninteen Shillings and ten pence Current money of Maryland and four hundred pounds of Tobacco and not more and because the said Thomas denies not this but the same allegation Confesseth to betune prays Judgment for those Damages, and above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges and to him adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties and it is Considered that the said Thomas Stanton Recover against the said William Hopkins his Damages and to the said twelve pounds, Ninteen Shillings and ten pence Current money of Maryland and four hundred pounds of Tobacco as also two hundred and fifty five pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges and to the same Thomas by the Court here at his Request and Consent of the parties and adjudged and the said debt in money &c. Thereupon ^{afterwards} the said William Hopkins present here in Court in his proper person, and thereupon the said William Hopkins at the prayer of the said Thomas Stanton by his attorney and is Committed into the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County there to remain until the said Thomas of the Judgment and should be fully Satisfied, the said Sher. to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent present here in Court took Charge of the said William accordingly &c.

Charles Ramsey - Thomas Boardman - Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said Thomas Boardman Late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of November next to answer unto Charles Ramsey of a plea of trespass upon the Case and that he should not fail &c. And the said Charles Ramsey by Francis Allen his attorney Complain against the said Thomas Boardman in the plea and as followeth &c.

Somerset County sh Thomas Boardman Late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Charles Ramsey of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. And whereupon the same Charles Ramsey by Francis Allen his Attorney Complain that whereas the said Thomas the tenth day of March Anno Domini one thousand Seven Hundred and thirty Two at Somerset County within the jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the same Charles in the sum of Six hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco as the Acc^t. thereof will appear and soe thereof being Indebted the said Thomas In Consideration thereof Afterwards to witt the same day and Year and at the County and within the said Jurisdiction Upon himself assumed, to the said Charles
