Whereupon the said William Hopkins in his proper person Comes and Defends the force and injury, when he and says that he cannot gainsay the action of the afo Thomas nor can he say but that he did affive upon himself in such manner and form as the afo Thomas above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Thomas by him by reason of the premises in that part sustained the said William Faith and confesseth that the afo Thomas hath sustained damage by reason of the premises further than his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appered twelve pounds Nineteen shillings and ten pence current money of Maryland and four hundred pounds of tobacco and not more and because the afo Thomas doth not thin but the same allegation confesseth to be true pray Judgment for those damages afo above Confessed together with his costs and charges afo to him adjudged her.

Therefore by consent of the parties afo it is Considered that the afo Thomas Stayton Recover against the afo William Hopkins his damages afo to the afo twelve pounds Nineteen shillings and ten pence current money of Maryland and four hundred pounds of tobacco as also two hundred and fifty five pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges afo to the same Thomas by the Court here at his request and consent of the parties afo adjudged and the afo defendant in my the Thereupon I immediately the said William Hopkins present here in Court in his proper person, and thereupon the said William Hopkins at the prayer of the afo Thomas Stayton by his attorney afo is committed into the custody of his firs. of Somerset County Hors to remaine while the said Thomas or the Judge afo should be fully satisfied, the said firs. to wit Joshua Caldwell gent present here in Court took Charge of the said William according by her

At Charles Ramsey. Command was given to the firs. of Somerset County that he should take the Thomas Boorman. Thomas Boorman late of Somerset County planter afo should be found in his Baileywicke and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning next the third Tuesday of Nov. Then next to answer unto Charles Ramsey of aplea of trespass upon the firs. and that whereof he should not fail her. And the said Charles Ramsey by Francis Allen his attorney Complains against the said Thomas Boorman in the place afo as followeth viz.

And Whereupon the same Charles Ramsey by Francis Allen his Attorney complains that whereas the afo Thomas the tenth day of March Ano Dom^t one thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Two at Somerset County within the jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the same Charles in the sum of six hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco as per the Acc^t. thereof will appear and see thereof being Indebted the said Thomas In Consideration thereof afterwards to witt the same day and year afo at the County afo and within the afo jurisdiction Upon himself assumed to the said Charles
