Lordships Justices at the day and place aforesaid to shew her: as within to him it was commanded, and the aforesaid John Newbold so forewarned and at the same day being solemnly called cometh not but makes default her: —

Whereupon the said John Scarbrough in his own proper person prays that upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case provided that the aforesaid Twenty Six Bushells of Indian Corn so aforesaid attached as of the Rights and Credits of the said Samuel Waterhouse may be condemned in the hands of the said John Newbold towards satisfying unto him his damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the same attachment.

Whereupon after James Shirley of Somerset County Gentleman present having Court undertaken by the said John Scarbrough according to act of assembly that if in case the said Samuel Waterhouse do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said John Scarbroughs claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be undue before the laying of the attachment aforesaid than he the said John Scarbrough shall make Restitution unto him the said Samuel Waterhouse of all or such part hereafter shall be so made appear to be undue as aforesaid that he the said James Shirley will do it for him: —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Twenty Six Bushells of Indian Corn of the value of Eleven Pounds and five pence and three hundred pounds of tobacco so aforesaid attached be condemned in the hands of the said John Newbold as of the Rights and Credits of the said Samuel Waterhouse to satisfy the said John Scarbrough his damage and Costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that the said John Scarbrough have hereof his Execution against the said John Newbold according to act of assembly aforesaid.

A. William Wye Esq^r . Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Nicholas Hodgson late of Somerset County Mariner, if he Nicholas Hodgson should be found in his Ballywick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Doding Crook the third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto William Wye of a plea of Treppes upon the case etc. and that therof he should not fail &c. — At which said Third Tuesday of June to wit the Nineteenth day of the said Month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three —

Came the said William Wye by Francis Allen his Attorney and Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise comes and make Return thereof to the Court hereunder ^{the next day following his} *Copy of Corpus* J. Caldwell Sheriff

And Whereupon his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his certain Writ of Habeas Corpus unto the Justices of his County Court of Somerset now here Seideth which said Writ doth these words videlicet Maryland p. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore her: To the Justices and Sheriff of Somerset County Court greeting Whereas Nicholas Hodgson is detained in the prison of our said County under the custody of you our said Sheriff at the suit of a certain William Wye Esq^r in a plea of trespass upon the case which said plea
