Martin by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said William Jones in oplate of the said paper upon the Case &c. According to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he or they have why the same goods Chattells Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their Hands ought not to be ~~indemnified~~ and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and heavy on ~~the~~ Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and know this writt Witness Robert King Justice of our said Court the twenty fourth Day of June in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion &c. and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred & thirty two.

Att which said third Tuesday of August to witt the fifteenth Day of the same month and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two being the day of the return of the said Witt ~~to~~ the said William Jones by Francis Allen his attorney and the Just. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following Viz. By Vertue of the within writt to me directed to the Justices within mentioned I Certifie that I did attach on the second day of August One thousand seven hundred and thirty two in the hands of Heber Whittingham as the goods and Chattells of the within named George Martin thirty six pounds four shillings current money of Maryland and one thousand pounds of tobacco and by John Dennis Ind. and by Richard Roe honest and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I did make known unto the said Heber Whittingham that he be and appear at the time and place within Com: Lained before the Justices within mentioned to show &c. as by the within precept I am Comanded so answer For God well please.

And the said Heber Whittingham garnishes of the aforesaid George Martin by William Beaufingham his attorney Cometh and prays Leave thereof to Impare here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Jones here also &c.

Att which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of November and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforesaid William Jones as the aforesaid Heber Whittingham by their attorneys aforesaid whereupon the same Heber prayes further Leave thereof to Impare here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William here also &c.
