Therefore it is Considered that the afd Johnson shal recover against the afd Philip Selby his Damages afd to the afd three pound ten Shillings Current money and one pound of Tobacco by the Ours afd in form afd afd as also seven hundred fifty Two pound of Tobacco to the same Johnson at his request for his Costs and Charges afd by the Ours of Increase adjudged and that the afd Philip be taken &c
