At William Coulbourn of Somerset County & Henry Miles late of Somerset County planter aforesaid
1733. Henry Miles Henry Miles of Somerset County in the province of Maryland was summoned to answer
unto William Coulbourn of a plea that he render unto him two hundred & Seven
teen pounds nineteen shillings and two pence current money of Maryland which to him he owe &
unjustly detains him.

And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney
saith that Whereas the said Henry the Seventeenth day of August Seventeen hundred and twenty eight
at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory did
acknowledge himself to be bound unto the aforesaid William in the aforesaid two hundred and Seventeen pounds
nineteen shillings and two pence money aforesaid to be paid unto the said William when he should be hereunto
Required yett the said Henry tho. often required the said two hundred and Seventeen pounds Nineteen shillings
and two pence to the said William hath not rendered but the same to him hitherto to render hath denied
and still doth deny and unjustly detain Whereupon the said William saith that he is worse and
hath damage to the value of forty pounds money £^s and thereof he brings this Suit & he
brings into Court here the writing aforesaid which the debt aforesaid from aforesaid William whose date is
the Day and Year aforesaid

Whereupon the said Henry Miles in his own proper person appears and stand upon the
said Henry Miles at the prayer of the aforesaid William by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give Special
Bail to the action aforesaid whereupon a certain Lewis Hale of Somerset County Esq^r. present here in Court
in his proper person undertook for the said Henry Miles and affirmed upon his self that if
in case the said William Coulbourn should recover Judgment against the aforesaid Henry Miles in
the plea aforesaid or that the said Henry Miles should be thrown out of Court that then he the said Henry
Miles should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body to the C^r
body of the Justices of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that the said Lewis Hale would
do the same for him .. &c And thereupon the said Henry Miles prayeth that the aforesaid William Coulbourn
may give Leeway for Costs in case that would be obtained against him in the plea aforesaid which is by the
Court Granted Thereupon William Coulbourn of Dorchester County planter present here in Court in his proper
person undertaken for the aforesaid William Coulbourn that in case he be nonsuited in the plea aforesaid or otherwise
legally cast that then the said William Coulbourn shall pay the Condemnation of the Court and all Costs averse
thereon to the said Henry Miles or that the said William Coulbourn of Somerset County planter will do it
for
