The making of proper provision for the equitable division of the stock among subscribers, in case more than the capital is *bona fide* subscribed,

And a limitation of the number of shares to be subscribed for by any one person.

Resolved, That a Committee of three be appointed by the Chair to proceed to Annapolis, and present a copy of the preamble and resolutions to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Delegates, with a request that they be read in each House.
