REPORT.

To the Honorable,

The General Assembly of Maryland:

Your Committee visited the site of the projected Hospital for the Insane, and examined carefully into the progress of the buildings, and the condition of the premises. The walls of about one-third of the entire edifice have been erected, roofed in, and the floors laid. The work is granite and brick; appears to have been done in a neat and substantial manner by the contractor. The floors have been well laid, and the timber carefully selected; indeed, the whole structure reflects credit upon the architect and his associates.
