120 of said Article: The County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county shall annually levy such sums of money as will give to each primary school district in said county, and the Centreville district, the nett and clear sum of three hundred dollars, to be ascertained and provided by the Commissioners of the School Fund, and shall, if authorized by the taxable inhabitants of school district number four, or any other school district in the county, levy such additional sum on said district for the use thereof, as a majority of the taxable inhabitants present at the annual meeting may require, not to exceed two hundred dollars per annum, and the sums so levied shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of the School Fund, and the collector of said county shall collect and pay the same to the said Treasurer, and shall be allowed the same per centage as for the collecting of county taxes, and his official bond shall be liable therefor.

Sec. 9. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
