On motion of Mr. Whitaker,

Leave was granted Messrs. Whitaker, Grahame and Bradley, to bring in a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore City and County Passenger Railway Company.

On motion of Mr. Lynch,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations, to report a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore City Passenger Railway Association, in pursuance of ordinance 44, section 7, of 1859, of the city of Baltimore.

Mr. Smith presented the memorial of Emanuel Myers, of Carroll county, praying the passage of an act appropriating a sum of money for expenses incurred under an indictment against him for kidnapping;

Which was read, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mr. Duvall, from a select committee, reported the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the commissioners of Montgomery county to levy a sum of money for the use of Capt. French Forrest, surviving administrator of Joseph Forrest, deceased; also,

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Vestry of Prince George's Parish in Montgomery county to hold a lot of land, not exceeding fifteen acres, for a parsonage and burying ground; Which were severally read the first time.

Mr. Watkins, from a select committee, reported the following bill:

A bill entitled, An act to amend the twelfth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto a new section changing and defining the bounds of election district No. 1, in Howard county;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Smith obtained leave of absence.

Mr. Stone, from a select committee, reported the following bill, with amendments:

A bill entitled, An act to empower the county commissioners of Washington county to lay off a new election district in said county, to be composed of parts of election districts No. 7 and 9 in said county, to cause the polls thereof to be held at Ringgold.
