The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills :

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 24th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, by amending the 19th section, relating to the recording of deeds, and by adding to said Article a new section, to make valid acknowledgments made before commissioners ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Invalid Deeds. Also,

A bill entitled, An act authorizing the Treasurer of the State, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to Captain John T. Sinn, a sum of money therein mentioned, for services rendered by the United Guards, by order of the Governor ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance. Also,

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Lloyd's Landing Wharf Company, at Lloyd's Landing, in Talbot county ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations. Also,

A bill entitled, An act to add the following section to Article 2d of the Code of Public Local Laws, fixing the compensation of jurors of Anne Arundel county ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings. Also,

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 12th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by amending the 97th section thereof, which authorizes the levy of a tax for the support of
