[Remarks.—In the memorials which were presented for signatures, there were no columns ruled in which reasons might be recorded for not voting other than actual violence and intimidation. Hence, those who did not vote for either of these reasons are placed in the last column of the foregoing table. The parties, however, who presented the memorials for signatures reported to the contesting committee that this portion of the memorialists, in general, verbally assigned as their reason for not voting, that the election was a mere farce or mockery, and that the exercise of their elective-right would be of no avail in the face of the fraud and violence perpetrated on the day of the election.]
