Ordered, That the Secretary of the Senate be requested in ordering the bills printed, to have retained the name of the originator of the bill, instead of substituting the name of the chairman of the standing committee to whom a bill may be referred.

Leave was granted the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill entitled, An act to change the name of Mary Wilson to Mary Duckett.

On motion of Mr. Lynch,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Union Express Company.

A bill entitled, An act in favor of the Maryland State Agricultural Society;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Agriculture. Also,

A bill entitled, An act for the benefit of the Baltimore city Protestant Episcopal Missionary Committee;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations. Also,

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 97th section of the 3rd Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to elections in Baltimore county, by directing that elections shall be held at such places as shall or may hereafter be established by law;

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Lynch, Grahame and Goldsborough, of Talbot.
