

The Clerk of the House of Delegates returned the following bills :

A bill entitled, An act for the relief of Josephine A. Buckler, by extending her term of instruction in the Maryland Institution for the Blind ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Mrs. Mary Tabler certain moneys erroneously paid ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act to provide for making indices to the land and other records in the Clerk's office for Charles county, and directing the county commissioners to levy, by a tax, a sufficient sum to pay for the same ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 118th section of the 18th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the pay of the sheriff of St. Mary's Court, for keeping prisoners, by increasing said pay ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate a company to construct a turnpike road from the city of Cumberland, by the nearest and most practicable line, to Bedford, Pennsylvania ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, An act to amend an act entitled, An act to incorporate the Green Spring Avenue Company, passed at January session, 1858, chapter 216 ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, An act for the relief of James Evans, a constable in and for the first election district of Baltimore county ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 116th section of the 22d Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, which authorizes the board of primary education in Worcester county to
