

TITLES OF THE RESOLUTIONS

1. Resolution reviving the Act of Assembly passed March 1st 1830, entitled, "an act to incorporate the Neoprene Steam-boat Company."
2. Resolution requesting the Representatives of Maryland in Congress, to take measures to obtain a treaty with the Government of Great Britain, relative to restitution of slave property, belonging to American citizens, which may be found in her possession.
3. Resolution directing the Adjutant General to loan to the General's Office a quantity of muskets, with the necessary accoutrements.
4. Resolution directing the Adjutant General to furnish to John H. Bunker, of Washington county, a musket or rifle, as directed in a certain act.
5. Resolution authorizing the Governor to procure a sword, with a scabbard, and ornaments, and present the same to the mother of the late Col. Dixon S. Miller, of the late war, as a testimonial of the high consideration and respect in which the brave State for his gallant heroic conduct, and meritorious military skill, displayed during the late war, holds her.
6. Resolution declaring the election held in the city of Baltimore, on the 2d of November last, void, and declaring James T. McKellicock, Comptroller of the State.
7. Resolution declaring the election of the Delegates to the General Assembly, from Baltimore city, void, and directing a writ for a new election to issue.
8. Resolution declaring the election, on the 2d November last, of the Court of the Circuit for Baltimore city, void, and directing said office as vacant.
