Mr. Goldsborough, of Talbot, submitted the following message:

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

We herewith transmit to your Honorable Body the accompanying bill, which has already passed the Senate, by which the Code of Revised Laws, prepared under a provision of the Constitution, is adopted and declared in force; and we respectfully recommend your Honorable Body to take immediate action with regard to the said bill, inasmuch as the prompt adoption of the Code will greatly facilitate the business of legislation at the present session.
