

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Comptroller to adjust the account of Henry M. Langly, collector of State taxes for the first election district of St. Mary's county, for the year 1851, and to allow as credits on the same all sums of money for which the State's attorney has receipted,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
